It is strongly recommended that every Qualifying Hound have been run previously alone and that to the handler's satisfaction runs cleanly and keenly. It is additionally recommended that every Qualifying Hound practice with other hounds prior to being presented for a qualifying courser test. It is to be understood by all that training prior to running a hound with other hounds in competition is essential to ensure that the hound is prepared to run safely with other hounds.

All dogs one year of age or older from the following breeds are eligible to participate in Lure Coursing Events.

- Dogs of these breeds recorded with the Purebred Alternative Listing Program/Indefinite Listing Privilege (PAL/ILP) or dogs with Conditional registration are eligible to participate.
- Spayed and neutered dogs are eligible to participate.
- Monorchid and cryptorchid dogs are ineligible to participate.
- Bitches in season are not eligible to participate.
- Hounds with breed disqualifications, as listed in the AKC Breed Standards, are ineligible to enter lure
 coursing trials and tests.
- Dogs with Limited Registration are eligible to participate.

Tests Offered

QUALIFIED COURSER (QC) CERTIFICATE: A hound at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed - or another breed with a similar running style - (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake.

JUNIOR COURSER: Open to all eligible sighthounds at least 12 months of age. A hound running alone must receive a certification from a Judge on one date, and a second certification from a different Judge at a later date, with each Judge stating that the hound completed a (minimum) 600-yard course with a minimum of 4 turns. The hound must complete the entire course with enthusiasm and without interruption. Ribbons (Dark Green) will be awarded to all hounds that successfully complete the AKC Junior Courser Test.

Stakes Offered

OPEN STAKE. Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate or ASFA certification. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). ASFA or CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. This copy must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC. Championship points earned from the Open Stake will only count toward a Field Champion title. Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Championship title are not eligible to enter the Open Stake.

VETERAN STAKE: Open to all hounds which are eligible to enter Open or Special stakes and meet the age requirement for a veteran as established by the breed's parent club – 6 years of age; except Irish Wolfhounds = 5 years, Whippets, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, and Afghan Hounds = 7 years. Championship points will be awarded. Points won from the Veteran Stake may count toward either a Field Championship title or Lure Courser Excellent title.

SPECIALS STAKE: Open to all hounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. Championship points earned from the Specials Stake will count toward Lure Courser Excellent titles. Qualifying scores earned from the Specials Stake will count toward a Senior Courser or Master Courser title.

Singles (Limited to 10 entries): Open to all sighthound breeds approved to participate in AKC Lure Coursing trials. Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Hounds entered in the Singles Stake shall not be allowed to enter the regular stakes (Open, Specials or Veteran) at the same event. Each hound shall run the course alone. The order of running shall be determined by random draw. Judges shall score a dog's performance the same as a regular stake. Singles Stake entries from all breeds shall be combined to determine placements. Placements shall be awarded based on the combined preliminary and final course scores. The winner of the stake shall not be eligible to compete in Best of Breed and/or Best in Field courses.

Hounds under disqualification from AKC, ASFA or CKC Field Trials may NOT be entered.

Best in Field (BIF):

Will be offered, Portuguese Podengo Pequenos and MISC/FSS breeds are not eligible to compete.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: All Hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Hounds not present at time of Roll Call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Battery powered, continuous loop, lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic bags or strips. Backup equipment will be available. The course will be reversed for the final courses. The members of GVFRRC reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.

THERE WILL BE A \$5 FINE ASSESSED FOR ANY LOOSE HOUND CAUSING DELAY OF TRIAL OR INTERRUPTING A COURSE IN PROGRESS.

AKC REGULATION FOR JUNIOR HANDLED ENTRIES

The regulations allow clubs holding herding, earthdog, lure coursing and coursing ability events to offer, at the club's discretion, a lower entry fee for dogs handled by Juniors. A Junior is defined as anyone younger than 18 years of age. The Junior must handle the dog in the class to qualify for the reduced entry fee. If the dog is entered under this provision but the Junior does not handle the dog, the owner must pay the regular entry fee as published. If offered, the reduced Junior entry fee shall be published in the premium.

The Junior handler's name MUST be in the space designated on the entry form for agent/handler. The reduced fee applies to PRE-ENTRIES ONLY.

THINGS TO KNOW

Owners entering hounds in the Qualifying Courser test are responsible for obtaining a hound of the same breed, or of similar running style, to run with the qualifying hound in the QC test.

- Do not send entries requiring a signature for delivery.
- Hounds must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial.
- Food will be available. Cost is \$5.00 if not working.
- Bring your own food, water, and shade.
- Owners must keep their hounds under control and clean up after them.
 There will be a \$5.00 fee charged for ANY owner caught not cleaning up after their animal.
- Weather and other conditions permitting, practice and puppy runs will be offered on <u>SATURDAY</u> after the trial - \$5.00 per run, per dog. NO PRACTICE WILL BE HELD ON SUNDAY.

Directions to the site:

From Route 287

Route 287 to Exit 10 toward New Brunswick. Take Easton Avenue to the first light. Make a right onto Cedar Grove Lane. Follow for two miles and make a right at the fourth light onto Weston Road. Follow to first light and make a left onto Elizabeth Avenue. Colonial Park is on the right. Drive all the way thru the park then make a right onto Mettlers Road. The Pine Grove entrance is the first right on Mettlers Road.

From Route 206

Southbound:
